## Isaiah 53:4-12 (ESV Text) and the Atonement

- <sup>1</sup>Surely he has <mark>borne our griefs</mark> and <mark>carried our sorrows</mark>; yet we esteemed him <mark>stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted</mark>.
- <sup>5</sup> But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.
- <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- <sup>7</sup> He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.
- <sup>8</sup> By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living, stricken for the transgression of my people?
- <sup>9</sup> And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, <mark>although</mark> he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth.
- <sup>10</sup> Yet it was <mark>the will of the LORD to crush him</mark>; <mark>he has put him to grief</mark>; when his soul <mark>makes an offering for guilt</mark>, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.
- <sup>11</sup> Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.
- <sup>12</sup> Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

\* The green use of "satisfaction" is concerning God's wrath (propitiation), and the red use concerns satisfying the demands of the law.
